I.- The **right to freedom of speech** and to hold ideas **is inherent to the human being and is prior to, and above, all laws**. Laws should be limited to recognizing the right to freedom of speech and articulating the defense of it, never granting it, allowing it, denying it or limiting it, since it is a superior right and prior to any law.

II.- **The right to take offense is not a right to silence anyone**. The right to express an idea or opinion is infinitely superior to the right of anyone to feel offended by that idea.

III.- Hate is a very ugly feeling, but **feelings are not a crime**.

IV.- **Any law that limits the right to have one's own ideas or to express them is an unjust law and does not deserve to or should be obeyed**.

V.- **Ideas have no rights**, rights belong to the individual

VI.- **Groups have no rights** other than those of their individuals and therefore no group, collective or association can or should have exclusive rights that are ultimately a theft of rights from those outside those groups.

VII.- **Any individual has the right to detest, abhor or find disgusting an idea**, a religion or an ideology as well as to find any of these to their liking

VIII.- **Any individual has the right to publicly express abhorrence, rejection, disgust, fascination or liking for any idea**, religion or ideology using any dialectical device such as ridicule, mocking, praise or logic entailing no penalty or sanction of any kind for doing so and without the offense of third parties involving any limit.

IX.- **The threat or the DIRECT invitation to violence are not freedom of expression**.

X.- **The defense of any other asset (common or individual) or right cannot be argued by the State or any other power to abrogate or limit freedom of expression under any circumstances**.
